WHAT DOES AN ONU HIGH SCHOOL SHOOTOUT OFFER? 2013

- Minimum of five games
- Possible sixth if team wins division
- Camp T-shirt (players & coaches)
- T-shirt sizes will be available at registration the first day of camp: Youth Large, Small, Medium, Large, XL, XXL
- Campers do not need to send in what size shirt they need
- Multiple divisions accomodate teams of all levels. Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Sophomore teams encouraged to register.

Directions to OLIVET NAZARENE UNIVERSITY

Local (from Bradley-Bourbonnais) Exit 315 off Interstate 57.

- If southbound on I-57, follow the exit ramp as it curves to the right onto Route 50 south.
- If northbound on I-57, follow the exit ramp to the traffic light. Then, turn left onto Route 50 south.
- Turn right onto Armour Road. (Denny's restaurant on the corner.)
- At the second traffic light, turn left onto Rt. 45. (Speedway gas station on the corner.)
- Olivet's Burke Administration Building is one-half mile south and is on the left.
- Continue on Rt. 45 to the second traffic light. Turn left onto University Avenue (main campus entrance).
- At the stop sign, turn left. Take the third left to McHie Arena.

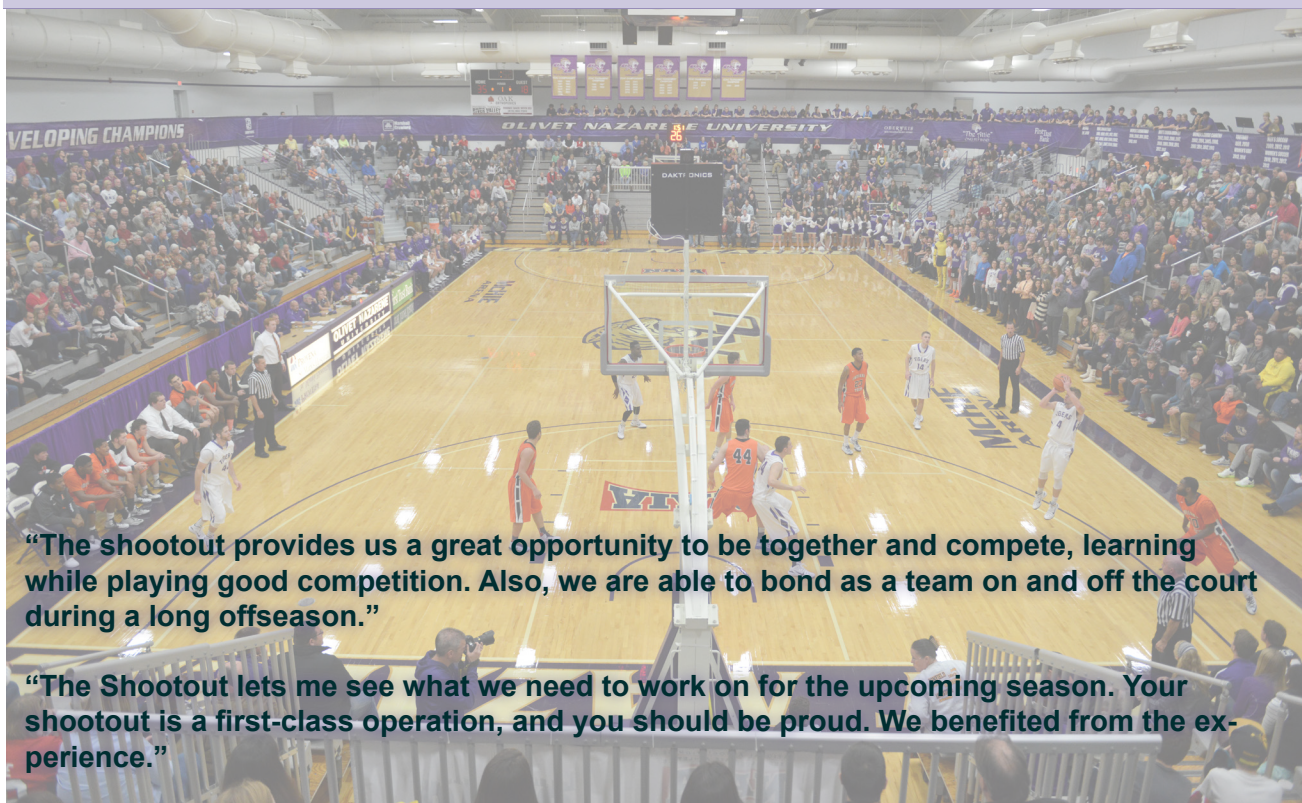
HS SHOOTOUT PURPOSE

Secondly, to offer an opportunity for players and coaches to begin to identify roles and build chemistry for next season.

HIGH SCHOOL SHOOTOUTS (*Please Read*)

COST – \$300 (1st team), \$250 (2nd team)

REGISTRATION – Each team needs to check-in to the Perry SLRC lobby on the campus of Olivet Nazarene University between 1:45 and 3 p.m. on the first day of the shootout. The Shootout begins approximately with a 3 p.m. game on Friday and a 8:30 a.m. game on Saturday. Checkout will begin at 12 p.m. on Saturday.

ENROLLMENT – Space is limited to the first 18 teams. **A verbal commitment along with your entire fee (per team) is encouraged by Friday, May 15.** Please call to ask for special arrangements.

HOUSING – A limited number of rooms are available on ONU's campus for a cost \$15 per resident. Additional housing is available through local hotels. See ONU's website for area information.

KEYS - If you decide to stay on Friday night you will be issued one key per player/coach. If the key is lost a \$10 fee will be charged.

GAMES/DIVISIONS – Each team is guaranteed a minimum of five games. A sixth game will be played by top two teams of each division (records through first five games decide title game). Divisions are chosen by ONU coaches, according to size of school and history of competitiveness. Preferences by HS coaches can be suggested, but all discretion is left up to ONU coaches.

OFFICIALS - Each game will have two IHSA-patched officials present. We make every effort to give our officials sufficient rest throughout each session.

TEAMS – Each team is encouraged to bring eight players and numbered light and dark team shirts. Each school is encouraged to bring more than one team. Junior Varsity/Sophomore teams are invited. **We will host a division for these teams if enough register.**

Concessions will be available to players, coaches, parents and fans. (specific hours will apply)
