(i) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Registration: Registration will not be capped at any point but sign-up and full payment is encouraged by Monday, May 18. We will accept walk-up registrations on the first day of camp, but do not encourage it. A confirmation email, including additional information, will be sent out following registration.

Important Times/Dates: Registration is between 3:45-5:00 PM in the lobby of McHie Arena on Sunday, June 21. Camp begins with a 5:30 PM session. Camp will end on Wednesday, June 24 at approximately 11:00 AM following the 3-on-3 Tournament; once your son is finished playing he can check out of his room. Commuters check-in is from 4:30-5:00 PM.

Housing/Meals: A designated University residence hall and Ludwig cafeteria will be used for housing and meals. Location and additional information will be provided at check-in. All rooms will be air—conditioned. Sunday's meal will not be provided until 8:30 PM. It is recommended to eat before check-in.

Housing Requests: Parents/campers can request roommates during check-in the first day of camp or on registration form. (Most rooms have two beds, limited rooms with three).

Key Deposit: A \$10 key deposit will be required at registration. It will be returned at completion of camp in exchange for key.

Waiver Form: A lability waiver form is required for each camper and will be available to sign at check-in on the first day of camp.

What to Bring:

- Swim trunks (Perry SLRC pool will be open on Monday and Tuesday evening for campers)
