- Location:** 1763 E 4000N Rd. Bourbonnais, IL 60914 (Behind Northfield Square Mall)
- Races:** 5:00pm Women's 5k  
5:45pm Men's 8k
- Competition:** Unlimited entries. Unattached entries allowed with approval of the meet director.
- Entry Procedure:** Please enter your team using [runnersedgeracetiming.com](http://runnersedgeracetiming.com). If you have any questions about the entry procedures please call Derek at 231-855-1282. The entry deadline is:  
**Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> by 6:00pm.**
- Entry Fee:** \$200 per men's and women's teams; \$400 combined; unattached runners are \$20 each.  
Checks are payable to Olivet Nazarene University.
- Course:** Aspen Ridge is a primarily flat course with gentle inclines. The course will open at 3:30 pm Friday, September 9th.
- Packets:** Packet pickup will be located at the clubhouse starting at 2:30pm. Please note that any teams with race chips not turned in after the races will be subject to a \$40 fee per chip.
- Restrooms:** Port-a-Johns will be available near the start/finish area. Please ask if locker room facilities will be needed after the meet.
- Trainers:** A certified athletic trainer and student athletic trainers will be located near the start/finish area.
- Results:** Results will be posted on Runner's Edge, [onutigers.com](http://onutigers.com) and [tfrs.org](http://tfrs.org) after the races.
- Awards:** Official results will be announced at approximately 6:30pm. The top 15 individuals receive t-shirts, and the winning team receives a plaque.
- Check ins:** Runners must report to the starting line 15 minutes prior to the start of their races.
- Team Camps:** Camps may be set up on the golf course, away from the fairways, greens, and tees.
- Parking:** Parking is available at the course. Overflow parking is across the street at the mall.  
All team buses will be asked to drop off their athletes then park across the street.
