Repeat performance

In the 2015 home opener, ONU came out on top against Midland University (Neb.) 27-21, their opponent from week one this season. The Tigers got out to a 21-6 first half start using a dominant rushing game and capping off the first half with a Rashaan Gaymon 69-yard touchdown catch. The defense only gave up 211 total yards to the Warriors. Olivet will look to do the same this year, winning their first game at home under the leadership of head coach Eric Hehman.

After a week one loss to Midland this season, Olivet looks to respond against a top-five matchup against the University of St. Francis (Ind.). The Cougars are coming off a week one win over TIU, 34-20, and defeated the Tigers 59-16 at home a year ago in the second week of the season. Saturday's game at BBCHS is the first of four games this season against top 25 opponents.

In week one's game against Midland ONU benefited from using the deep pass in the second half scoring twice off 80-yard plus pass plays. With 7:22 to go in the third quarter freshman Keandre Murph scored on a 80-yard pass from freshman Jordan Lawton. ONU's final points of the game came in the fourth quarter when the very explosive Rashaan Gaymon scored a touchdown on a 95-yard play. It broke the record for longest reception and pass in a single game in ONU history.

Four of the Tigers' top six receivers return from last years team that caught 248 balls for 2,262 yards (9.1 avg.) for 18 touchdowns. Leading the pack is Rashaan Gaymon who had 20 catches for 257 yards in only three games played. Alvin Best caught 20 balls for 350 yards. Erik Anderson caught 27 balls for 181 yards out of the backfield. Senior Matt McDivitt returns, he finished second on the team with 37 receptions for 360 yards.

ONU's top two linebackers and tacklers return for a second and third year. Junior Sebastian Swift and sophomore Caleb Coe will help anchor the defense in tonight's game against one of the nation's top offenses. Swift led ONU in tackles (139) last season and is on the College Football America 2016 Yearbook Starting Lineup. Coe was second with 114 tackles and had eight and a half for loss in his freshmen year.

In 2015 the Cougars averaged 46.9 points per game, third best in all of the NAIA. St. Francis (IN) scored over 30 points in all but one game and 40-plus in eight games last year Their season-high was 74 against Lindenwood-Belleville. The Cougars' finished sixth in the NAIA in yards per game (493.8) and passing yards per game (307.7). Not to mention, quarterback Nick Ferrer led the nation in passing touchdowns with 40.

ONU's opponent today in their home opener is not only the No. 4 ranked team in NAIA Top 25 preseason poll, they are coming off a 11-1 season and a NAIA FCS Semifinal berth. Teh Cougars fell to eventual national champion, Marian University (Ind.), who is ranked No. 1 in the preseason poll in 2016. They won the MSFA Mideast League winning by an average of 32.7 points.

PLAYERS TO WATCH

WR Rashaan Gaymon (SO)

In his first game back after suffering a season-ending injury in his freshman season, Gaymon led the Tigers with three catches for 134 yards and one touchdown against Midland in week one. Not to forget, his 95-yard catch and score in the fourth quarter was a record-breaking performance for a single-game reception. He also had four kickoff returns for 102 yards. Gaymon only played three games last year but showed his speed and talent, finishing fifth for the Tigers in catches and yards and led the team in touchdowns. Last year against the Cougars he led ONU with six catches for 67 yards, catching one for a touchdown. He also had seven returns for 195 yards, one for 53 yards.

LB Caleb Coe (SO)

One of two freshmen to be named MSFA Midwest Honorable Mention in 2015, Coe finished second on the team with 114 tackles, eight and a half for loss (36 yards), and two sacks. He was one of six Tigers to start all 11 games and the only freshman to do so. Against the Cougars in the second week of the season last year, Coe had 12 tackles, one for loss (11 yards), one sack for 11 yards and one forced and recovered fumble. In week one against Midland he had seven tackles (0.5 for loss).

QB Nick Ferrer (JR)

The Cougar quarterback went 19-for-37, throwing for 323 yards and two touchdowns in week one in a 34-20 win over Trinity International. Ferrer is looking to follow up a terrifc sophomore season where he was selected MSFA Mideast First Team Offense as the only quarterback on the team. Last season he threw 40 touchdowns, completing 223 passes for 3,476 yards. Last season against the Tigers he went 12-for-19, throwing for 216 yards and five scores.

DE Lucas Sparks (SR)

A MSFA Mideast First Team Defense selection a year ago led the Cougars in tackles for loss (13.5, 92 yards) and sacks (10, 73 yards). He finished third in the MSFA in sacks and seventh in tackles for loss. He was second on the team with 76 tackles and had six (1.5 for loss) against the Tigers on Sept. 5 a year ago. Sparks also finished with a sack for 10 yards and a pass break up.
